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What is a CSP Coordinator?

A CSP Coordinator focuses on the needs of families of children with complex needs to make it easier to access services that are right for them.

CSP Coordinators link families to programs and services, creating a shared plan with common goals so you don't have to retell your story over and over again.


How CSP Helps Families

-  One main contact person
-  Don't have to repeat your story and goals to multiple providers
-  One single plan. Providers work together towards common goals

Family-Centered Approach



-  We consider the strengths and needs of all family members
-  We support families in making decisions
-  We recognize that families are the experts on their child's needs



Who can access CSP?

Our CSP program is available to Mushkegowuk families of children and youth with special needs from ages 0-18 or 18-21 if still in school.

Families can access the program early on, when developmental concerns are identified, when the family situation changes, when new needs are identified or when new services are added.

1 Referral or Self Referral

3 Develop a Plan

You will develop a plan for your child

4 Follow-Up
